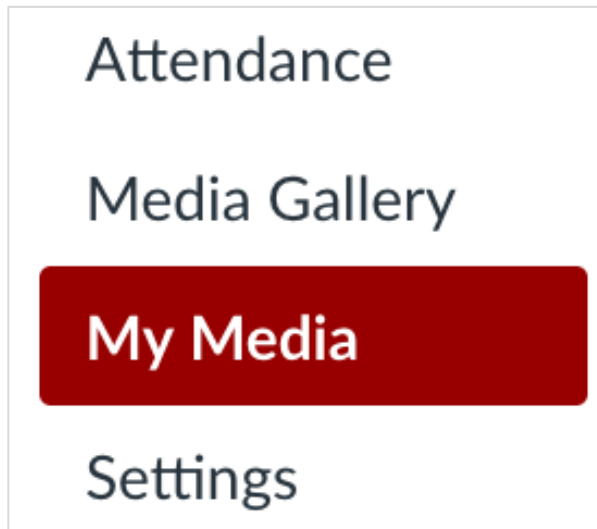


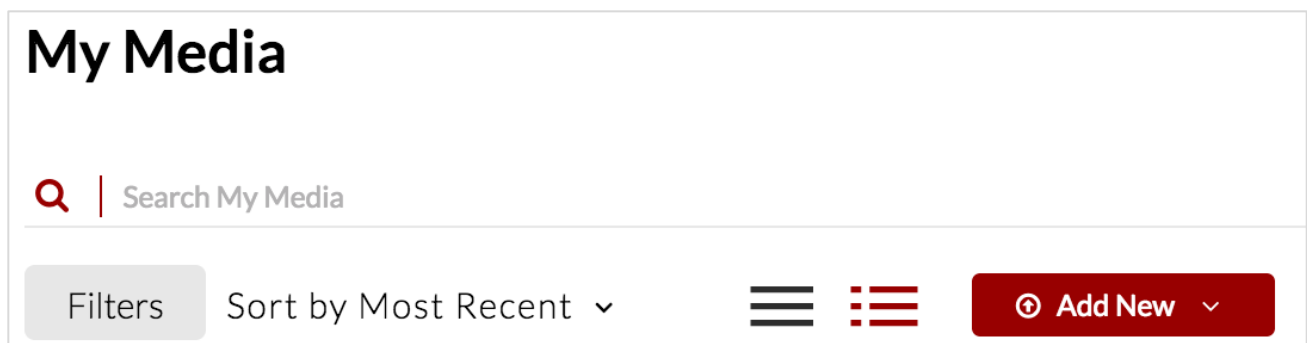
Step 1: Open My Media
